2018 NM SHOOTING SPORTS LEADER CERTIFICATION February 16-18,



Next Leader Certification is scheduled in Las Cruces, NM. Training will be offered in shotgun, rifle, pistol, hunting, archery, and muzzleloading. The policy for maintaining certification, according to our policies and procedures, is as follows:

Maintaining State 4-H Shooting Sports Certification

a. To maintain certification an instructor/leader must be active two out of three consecutive years. If inactive for two consecutive years, re-certification is required.

NEW MEXICO 4-H LEADERS' ASSOCIATION

Applications for the Executive Board positions are *due by October 15*.

Duties include:

- Y Plan the annual New Mexico 4-H Adult Forum.
- Y Communicate with County 4-H Leader Associations in their district for the expansion improvement, and promotion of 4-H youth and leader educational programs.
- Y Advise the State 4-H Program Leader on matters of program policy and future directions.
- Y Transact necessary business of the Association.

AMBASSADOR/ DIPLOMAT APPLICATIONS

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Any **mature, devoted** New Mexico senior 4-H'er who will remain an eligible 4-H member during the year of service, January 2018 through January 2019. The 4-H member must be a New Mexico resident during the year of service. An Ambassador or Diplomat cannot serve simultaneously as a State 4-H Council Officer. The candidate must be an active 4-H member in good standing with his or her club and council.

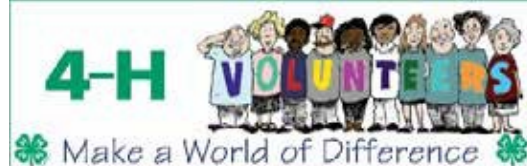

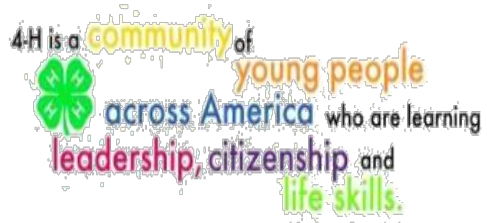

4-BB RECORD BOOKS



At the end of each year, Record **Books** are used to determine the accomplishments of 4-H members in project work, leadership, citizenship and overall achievement. The Record **Book** judging process is used to award project pins and other special awards at the annual 4-H Awards Program. Because it is a competitive activity there has to be consistency on how books are compiled to insure that they are judged fairly. Members must compile their book, containing all of the sections, by following the format outlined in this guide.

How Is Your Record Book Judged?

Cover and Dividers.....	5 points
Individual Picture.....	5
Report Form.....	20
4-H Story.....	20
General 4-H Pictures.....	5
Project Records	20
Correspondence, Special Activities, etc.....	5
Leadership, Citizenship, Community Service.....	15

1. Establish goals (decide what you want from a project).
2. Assume responsibility (turn your goals into reality).
3. Collect data (keep a record of cost, savings, experiences and dates).
4. Evaluate progress (what did I learn, does it relate to my goals, was the cost justified, and did I help others)?
5. Earn Special Awards, which include Outstanding Novice, Junior and Senior Buckles

4-H Member Ages For 2017-2018 4-H Year



CLOVERBUDS: 5 to 8, years old AND in Kindergarten, 1st or 2nd grade (Born, 2009, 2010, 2011 or 2012)

NOVICE: 9 to 11 years old or 8 years old AND in the 3rd grade. (Born in 2006, 2007, 2008 or born in 2009 AND in 3rd grade)

JUNIOR: 12 and 13 years old or 11 years old AND in 6th grade. (Born in 2004, 2005 or born in 2005 AND in the 6th grade)

SENIOR: 14 to 18 years old OR 13 years old AND in 8th grade (Born 1999, 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003 or born 2004 AND in 8th grade)

Youth who are 19 on or by December 31 of the current 4-H year (2017) are NOT eligible to enroll as a 4-H member. If you were born in 1998 or before, you are too old for the 2017-2018 4-H year. **BUT, we would love to have to have you as a Volunteer Leader!**
