

5 STEPS TO EXHIBITING YOUR 4-H PROJECT

1. <u>Review the List of Your Enrolled 4-H Projects.</u>



 Find and Review the List of 4-H Project Exhibits related to your 4-H Projects in the Rio Arriba County Fair Book. Each Class is an opportunity for you to exhibit the skills you learned and gained through your 4-H Project.



Remember: For 4-H Projects which have advancing levels, (for Example, Leathercraft I, II, and III & Advance), you will need to be sure to select the project level you are enrolled in and the respective list of classes for that 4-H Project Level.

- 3. <u>You may exhibit one item per Class.</u> When Completing the Exhibit(s) listed under your 4-H Project, pay close attention to the Exhibit Requirements for Size, Labeling, Packaging, etc.
- 4. <u>To Register your 4-H Project Exhibits, locate the corresponding</u> <u>Registration Form:</u> Perishable Form (Baking, Cake Decorating, etc.), Non-Perishable Form (Woodworking, Welding, Animal Science, etc.), and Livestock Form (Poultry, 4-H Beef Project, etc.). <u>Complete the registration form in its entirety</u>.
- 5. Submit the Completed Form(s) to the Rio Arriba Cooperative Extension Service Office by the registration deadline on Monday, July 15th 4:00 pm. Non-perishable Project Exhibit Items are submitted with the Completed Registration Form. Perishable Exhibit items are accepted on Wednesday, July 24th.
