



5 STEPS TO EXHIBITING YOUR 4-H PROJECT

1. Review the List of Your Enrolled 4-H Projects.



2. Find and Review the List of 4-H Project Exhibits related to your 4-H Projects in the Rio Arriba County Fair Book. *Each Class is an opportunity for you to exhibit the skills you learned and gained through your 4-H Project.*



Remember: For 4-H Projects which have advancing levels, (for Example, Leathercraft I, II, and III & Advance), you will need to be sure to select the project level you are enrolled in and the respective list of classes for that 4-H Project Level.

3. You may exhibit one item per Class. When Completing the Exhibit(s) listed under your 4-H Project, pay close attention to the Exhibit Requirements for Size, Labeling, Packaging, etc.



4. To Register your 4-H Project Exhibits, locate the corresponding Registration Form: Perishable Form (Baking, Cake Decorating, etc.), Non-Perishable Form (Woodworking, Welding, Animal Science, etc.), and Livestock Form (Poultry, 4-H Beef Project, etc.).



Complete the registration form in its entirety.

5. Submit the Completed Form(s) to the Rio Arriba Cooperative Extension Service Office by the registration deadline on Monday, July 15th 4:00 pm. Non-perishable Project Exhibit Items are submitted with the Completed Registration Form. Perishable Exhibit items are accepted on Wednesday, July 24th.
