The day of the contest the food category that will be prepared will be announced: main dish, fruits and vegetables, breads and cereal or nutritious snack. One category will be selected and announced at check-in the day of the contest. will be a set of secret ingredients to be used in preparation, 4 for Seniors, 3 for juniors, 2 for Novices. Pantry items that are provided will be typical of what is found in a pantry at home, for example: canned goods, dry goods, crackers, cereal, chips, and spices.

They will present to the judges a single plated serving of the dish created. Dishes prepared will be evaluated by judges for safety practices, preparation and management. Teams should plan to not have access to a kitchen facility and bring only specific items to contest that are allowed. They will highlight their knowledge of My Plate nutrition facts, food preparation, safety concerns and practices, serving size information, and cost analysis of the dish prepared.


STATE FAIR ROOMS DEAL
